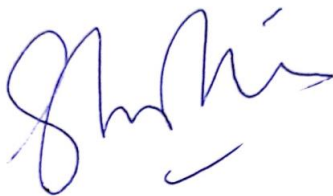
Submission of a research article to Special Issue BIOSSES 2022 of Squalen Bulletin of Marine and Fisheries, Postharvest and Biotechnology
